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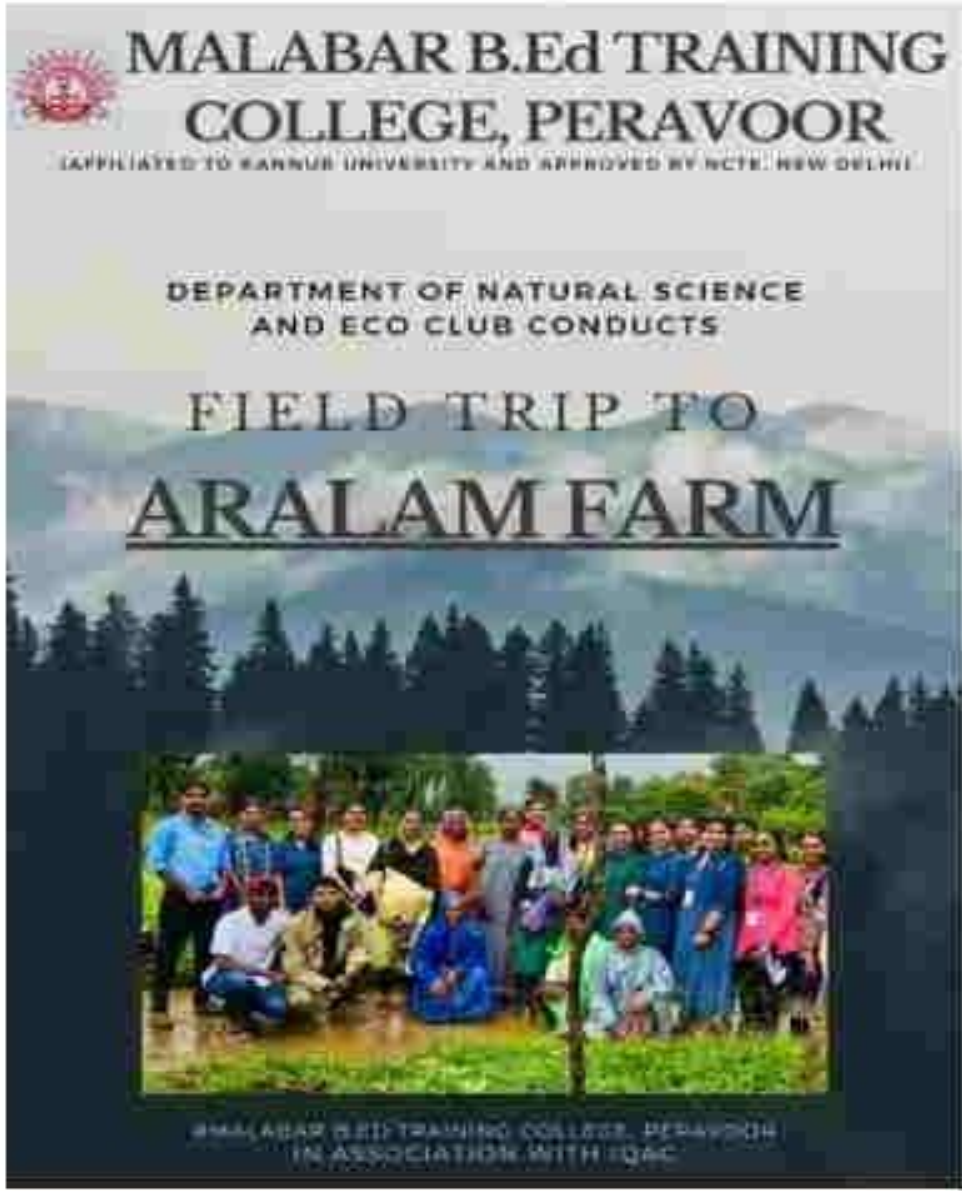

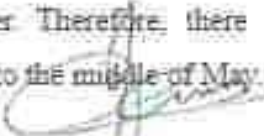
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A field trip is an outdoor lesson which provide opportunities for learning through the experience and the use of many techniques other than reading and speaking. Natural science option of Malabar B.Ed training college has visited 12 th block of Aralam farm on 04/07/2023. The field trip was coordinated by department of Natural Science and Eco club in association with IQAC. The trip includes 15 teacher students with principal Indu K Mathew, natural science option teacher Bhavya and one of the college faculty Meera. The field trip was guided by Agriculture officer Mr. Sunesh.

Aralam Farm was established by the Government of India in the year 1970 with the assistance of erstwhile Soviet Union. It is situated in the Kappad and Aralam Villages of the Thalassery Taluk of Kannur District, 56 km away from Thalassery and Kannur Town and 16 km from Iritty Town. It was subsequently taken over by the SC & ST Development Department, Government of Kerala, to distribute half of the area to the landless tribals and to run the remaining area as a Farm for the welfare of tribals. Aralam Farming Corporation (Kerala) Limited, a fully Government owned Company, under the administrative control of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes Development Department, was incorporated on 10th June 2010.

The main objectives of the Farm are to produce and distribute quality planting materials of plantation/horticultural crops, commercial production of crops in large scale, and above all to provide all manner of support services to further the social and economic welfare of the tribals resettled in Aralam. Farm is spread over 1530 hectares of land, encircled by rivulets and the Aralam Wildlife Sanctuary. Aralam Farm is the single largest producer of Coconuts in India. The Company also specializes in the production of quality planting materials of various plantation and horticultural crops to meet the growing demand of the farming community in the State and nearby States. The Farm land was originally under forest tree growth and the entire vegetation was clear-felled between the years 1970 and 1975 and taken up for cultivation for plantation crops. The Farm is situated at an elevation ranging from 50M to 1145M, the highest peak being Kattibetta. Atmospheric temperature varies from 21 to 40 degree Celsius at the foot hills and 8 to 25 degrees Celsius at higher levels. The Farm experiences humid tropical climate with annual rainfall ranging from 2500 to 5000 mm. Though the rainfall is very high, the entire precipitation is received during a period of about 6 months from the middle of May to the end of November. Therefore, there is a very conspicuous summer season from the beginning of December to the middle of May.




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RED CHILLY

We were all reached at Keezhpally at 10 am. There are two jeeps were arranged for our journey to Aralam farm. We were met Sumesh sir at the check post and then he guided us to the 1.5-acre chilly plot. It was a rainy day. But the workers were actively doing their work even when it was raining. Sumesh sir has introduced the chilly plot and explained the about the method, fertilizer and cultivation, processing and shipping of chilly and clarified our doubts. About 1.5-acre plot was planted by chilly by using Drip irrigation venture Method. The fertilisers mainly using are Akthari and COC. It is provided in the ratio of 30 ml in 3 litre waters. After 1 hr workers will check each plant is they got the mixture or not. For avoiding weed the mud is covered by plastic sheet. The phosphorus nitrogen and potassium ratio was 19:19:19. No red and yellow fertilizers are using here. About 60 to 65 days are the period for the chilly cultivation. The workers are the Mahatma Gandhi rural employment guarantee scheme members. More than 10 tribal community were actively working in Aralam farm. In this tribal communities paniyar trib are considered to be the original tribal people. There are 16 workers working in ubichilly field. While processing period no chemical is adding to the chilly that's why it became one of the best of all chili powder. The sale was carried by eco shops and a team of Karmasena. The price for 1kg chilly powder is 1000 Rs. When it compared to rate in market, it is high. So, the sale is limited and the people who were aware about the chemicals used in chilies are primary customers of this chilly. Sumesh sir has told that the agricultural department, the education department and the health department are only people who are promoting the chilly powder. The export of chilly powder is now in discussion and the team is to overcome many obstacles to fulfil the dream.




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MILLETS

After visiting the chilly farm, we had got the opportunity to visit Millet farm. It was really beautiful to see the farm. Millets are group of highly variable small seeded grass widely grown around the world as cereal crop or grains for both human food and fodder. They can have a pivotal role in the prevention of severe health issues. Millets are rich source of fiber and minerals, enriched with goodness of nature. The cold breeze of rainy weather was making us to feel fresh inside along with the green grasses of millet which are mended by tiny tree branches, which was made for protecting the farm land from wild animals. (The place where the plantlets are transplanted)




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MARIGOLD

After visiting the millet plot next, we had visited a beautiful garden with lots of yellow marigold and in between the yellow flower we could see orange flower which was very rare in our locality. Most probably the marigold can be cultivated in early summer until hard frost in late fall. Sumesh sir told us that sowing of marigold can be done around the year. In rainy season, sowing is done in mid-June and transplanting in mid-July. In winter sowing is done in mid of September and the transplantation completed in mid October. Sir told that mostly these flowers are sold in market for making bouquets and also there were many workers in the field for the proper maintenance. Later we wander around the field and we enjoyed the enchanting beauty of that land a lot and from there then our wise chair person Drya Joseph told our sincere thanks to Sumesh sir and to the workers of the field. After visiting the entire field we stopped at black plum tree to have the sweet and sour plum to make our trip even sweeter. The Trip was really an informative, wonderful and memorable one. After that we were left the field by 12 pm.

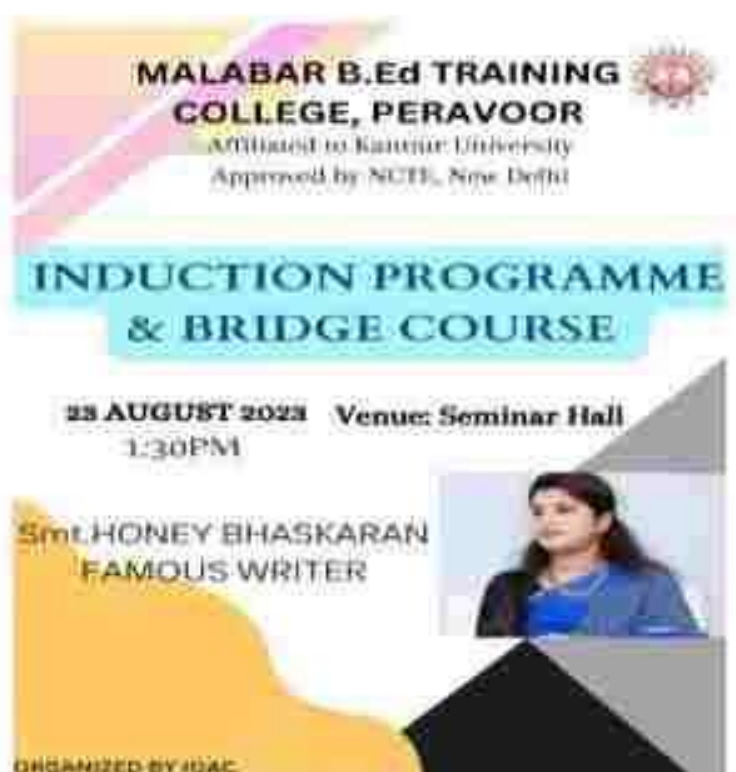

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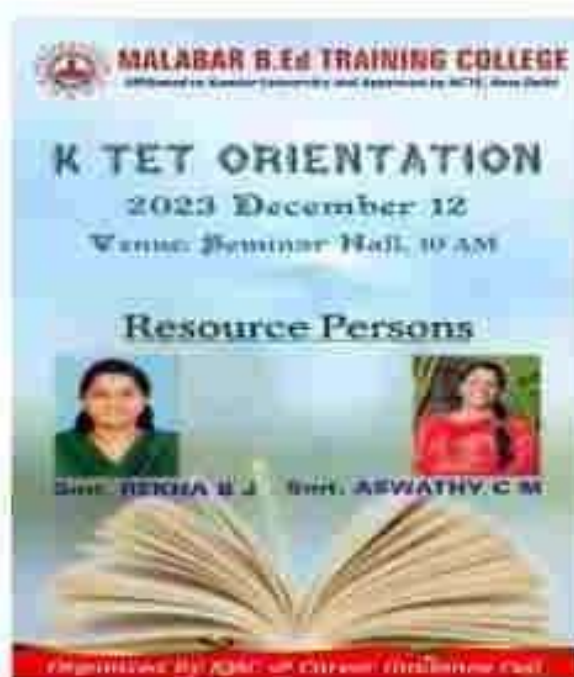

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K TET ORIENTATION CLASS

The KTET is an important examination for individuals who wish to become educators in Kerala. The exam is mandatory for individuals who wish to apply for teacher positions in the state's lower primary, upper primary, and high school levels. Passing the KTET is also considered as a significant step in the career development of an educator. It not only opens up job opportunities in the state but also demonstrates a candidate's commitment to their profession and their readiness to take on the responsibilities of a teacher. Keeping in view the above, Malabar B. Ed Training College Peravoor in association with IQAC and the Career guidance cell organized a K TET orientation class.

Objectives

To Familiarize students with the syllabus, exam pattern, and preparation strategies of the K TET examination.

Methodology

The methodology of the workshop is as follows:

1. Duration of the workshop: The workshop was of short duration of two hours.




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2. Participants: The participants included the 108 B.Ed. students of Malabar B.Ed. training college.
3. Resource Persons: The resource persons for the workshops were Smt Rekha B J and Smt Aswathy C
4. Mode: The workshop was conducted in face-to-face mode.
5. Date: The workshop was held on December 12, 2023.
6. Venue: The workshop was organized in the Seminar Hall.

The workshop sessions

The first session was about the creation of awareness about the KTET exam pattern. Before beginning the studies and planning, candidates should first analyze the exam pattern. The students familiarized themselves with the exam pattern for each class category, including the exam's medium, the type of questions asked, the marking scheme, etc. The next discussion was about the category-wise minimum cut-off for the exam. The first session was handled by Smt. Aswathy C M.

The second session was about discussing the syllabus for the exam. Before going through KTET preparation tricks, candidates should be familiar with the KTET syllabus. This is significant because it allows you to study each topic appropriately based on its weight. If candidates plan a syllabus-oriented KTET preparation strategy they will have enough time for revision.

The third session was the discussion of important questions from the topics of psychology and teaching aptitude. There was also a discussion about the previous year's questions on the above-mentioned topics. The class ended up with a doubt-clearing session and a time for feedback.

Conclusion

The workshop was focused on providing an orientation on the KTET examination. As indicated by the feedback of the participants the workshop was well received and appreciated by the participants.

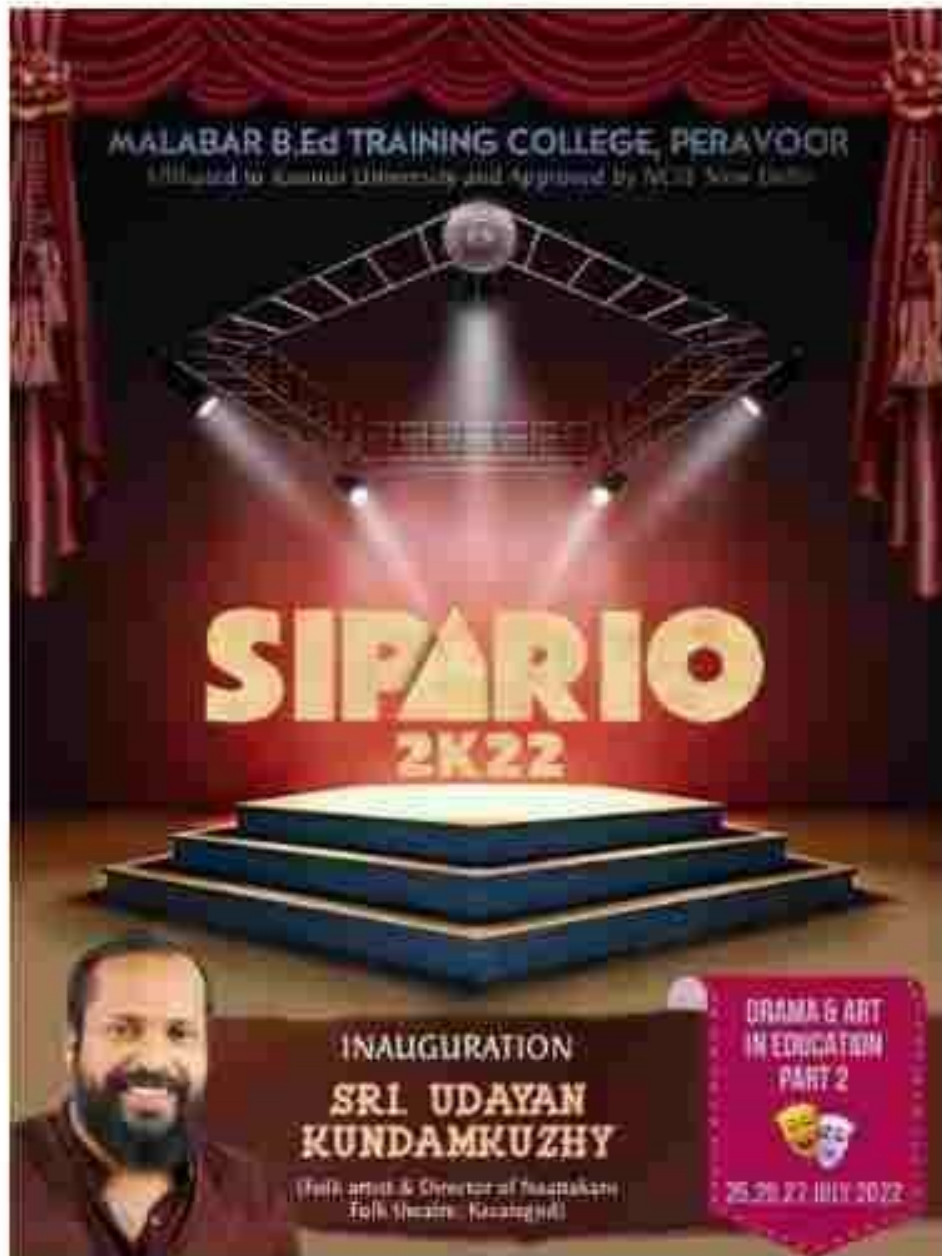

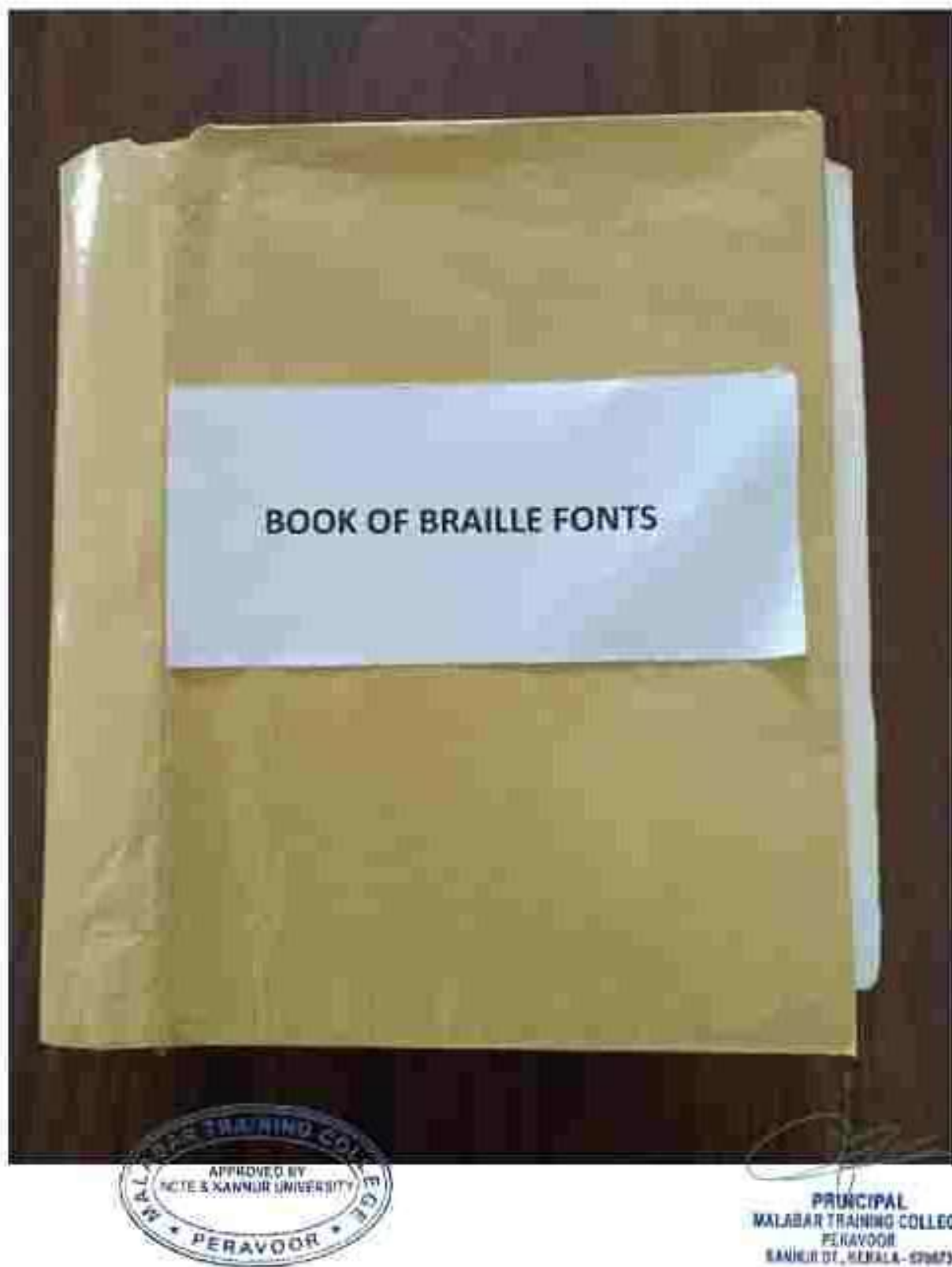



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Seminar session on Braille and Sign Language

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Special School Visit

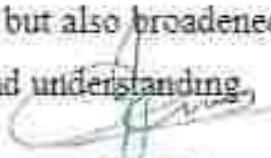

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SPECIAL SCHOOL VISIT VIKAS BHAVAN, EDOOR

A special school visit was conducted by Malabar B.Ed. Training College, Peravoor to Vikas Bhavan Edoor on 22 February 2023. All the students along with the teacher reached the school by 9.30 am. We spent a day with them. Vikas Bhavan Edoor is a special school which is managed by the Congregation of Mother of Carmel (CMC). The school was established in 1984. It started as a system of having a class of weekly once. Later in 1990, it was transformed into a school system. It is located in a rural area in the Iritty block of the Kannur district of Kerala.

The school is co-educational and it has a pre-primary section attached to it. The school accommodates students with all types of disabilities like autism, down syndrome, mental retardation, multiple disabilities, learning disability, etc. The school is divided into sections like pre-primary, primary, secondary, pre-vocational, and vocational. Students are admitted to each section based on their level and age. In the school, there are a total of 144 students. There are 30 staff. Out of 30 staff, 20 are teaching staff, and 10 non-teaching staff. In the pre-primary section students of 1.2 up to 5 years of age are admitted. In the vocational section, it is again divided into A, B, C, D, and E. In the E section, there are students up to the age of 40. Syllabus for students in special schools are designed based on their ability. It focuses on an individualized education policy (IEP). The school promotes students of each section to other sections based on their ability. It also promotes daily life activities. The children are trained to perform their daily activities on their own. They are taught to read and write. They were also given practice in extracurricular activities. In the vocational E section, students are trained to make candles, ropes, detergents, liquid dish wash, flowers, bouquets, garlands, etc. So they are trained to earn their livelihood. Students also reach the school by bus. Hostel facilities are



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available for both boys and girls. It is an unaided institution, but fees from students are not collected. The school is run by central government grants. The salary for teachers is provided by the management. Later when grants are sanctioned, salary is being distributed among students. Also, each student of the school gets a scholarship. The scholarship is based on a panchayat or state government scheme. Teachers in Vikas Bhavan are qualified with special B.Ed. Special D.Ed. Students are provided with behavior therapy, physiotherapy, and speech therapy. These have a lot of effects on children. Behaviour therapy modifies and shapes children. Disturbed and restless students become mild on doing this therapy. Physiotherapy is done for their motor skills. These therapies are provided 3 days per week. Co-curricular activities are offered like dance, music, and yoga.

Extra-curricular activities like dance, song, etc., were conducted by the students. The students of Vikas Bhavan were involved in all the programs. The involvement of external bodies like the Malabar B.Ed Training College in conducting visits and providing feedback reflects a commitment to continuous improvement and excellence in special education. Overall, Vikas Bhavan Edoor serves as a model for special education and deserves recognition for its valuable contribution to the community. It also helped the students to recognize the value of special schools and the way to treat special students.

These activities seemed to foster a sense of community and engagement among the residents. The staff members demonstrated professionalism and compassion in their interactions with the residents. They appeared attentive to the individual needs of each resident and were proactive in addressing any concerns that arose. Overall, the old age home visit provided valuable insights into the challenges and opportunities associated with elder care. While there are areas for improvement, particularly in addressing social isolation and healthcare needs, the dedication of the staff and the sense of community among residents were notable strengths. It was a remarkable experience for us.



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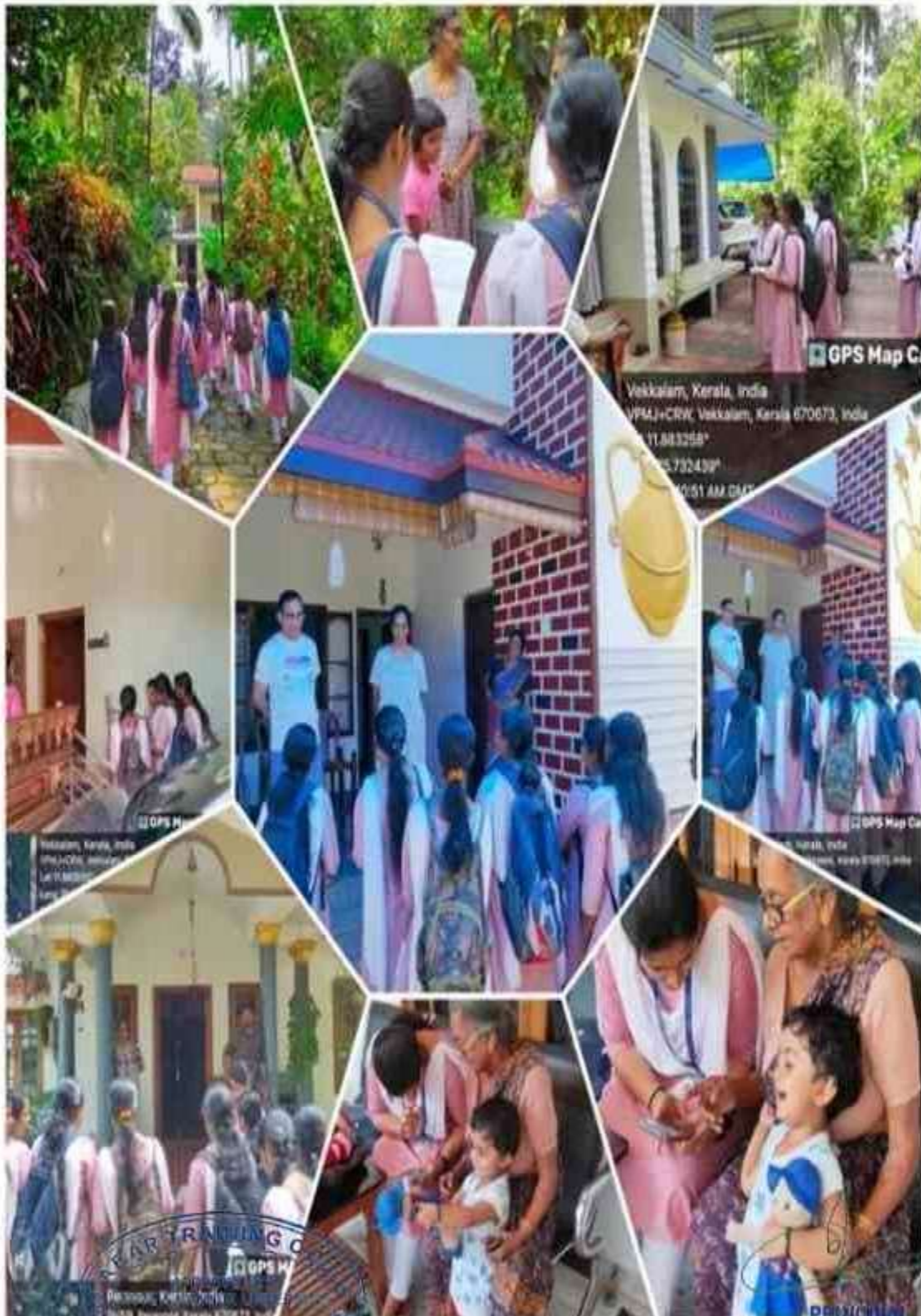

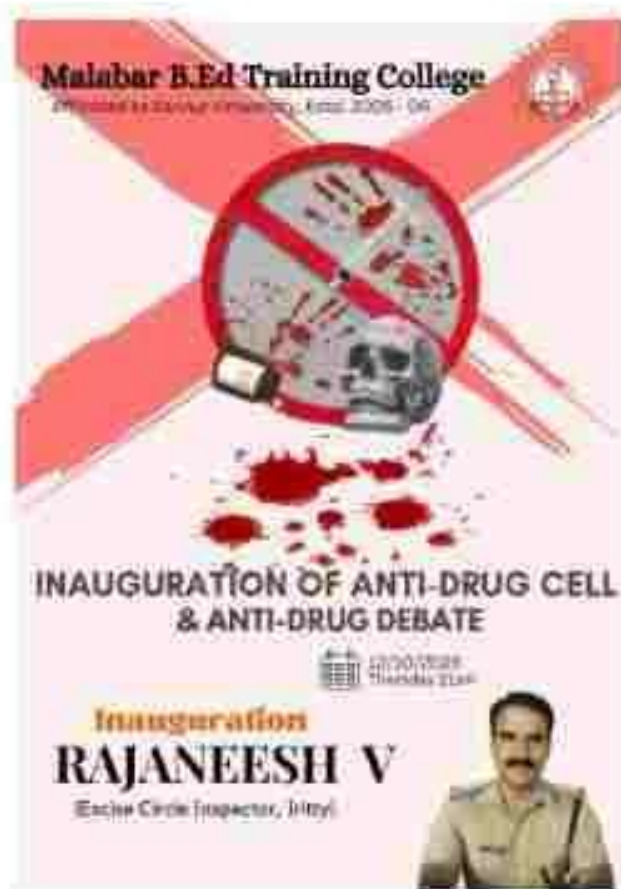
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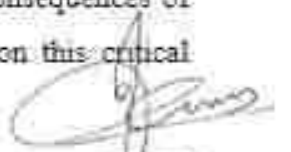
ANTI-DRUGS AWARENESS CLASS AND DEBATE

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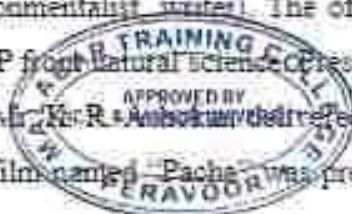
WORLD ENVIRONMENTAL DAY

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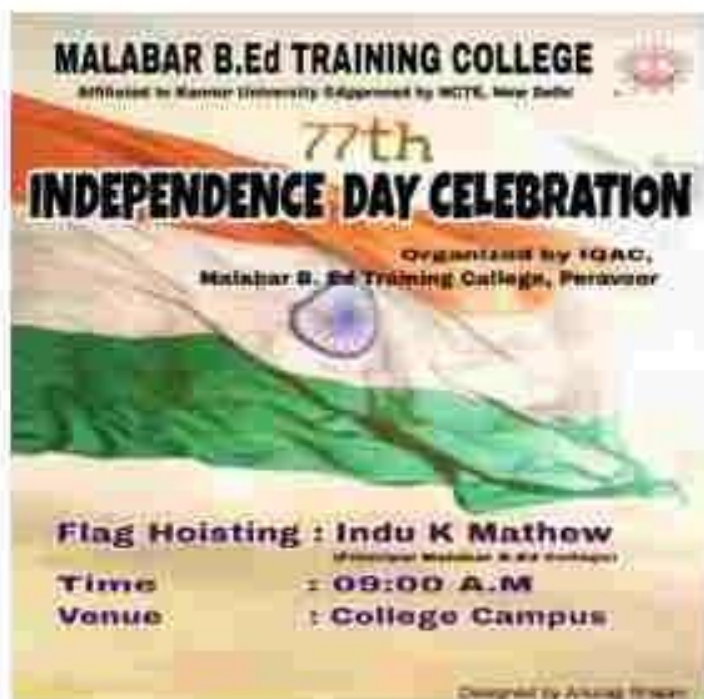
vote of Thanks was delivered by Sneha. The whole program was anchored by Jiya Sanam and Rosemary.

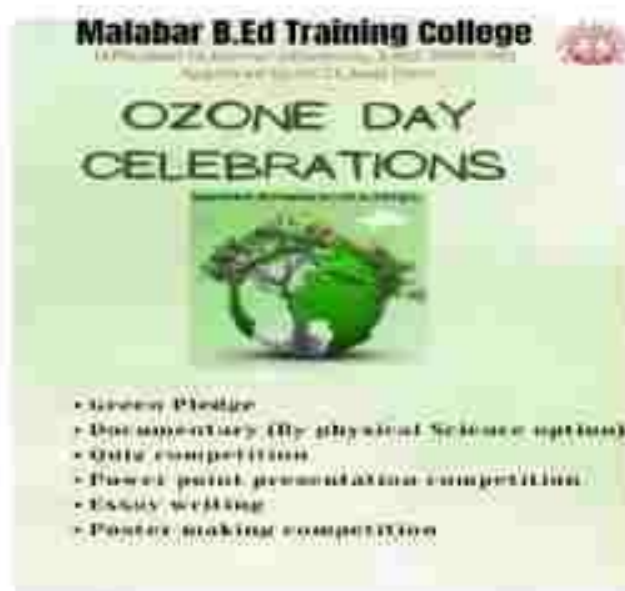
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OZONE DAY REPORT

27/11/2023



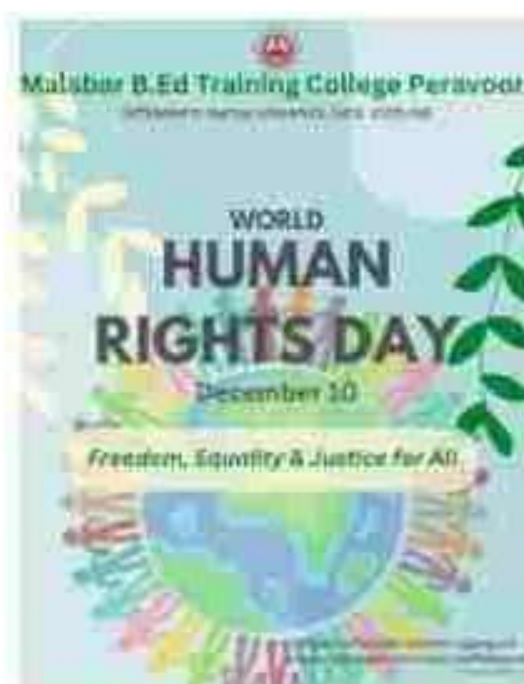
